The 12th edition of the EU Wine Law School is hosted by the University of Reims School of Law as part of the Wine & Law Program.


Located in the heart of Champagne, the University of Reims delivers a 5-day intense course program, entirely in English, on the legal aspects of wine trade within and with the European Union.


